We want to find a place for you in Victory Care that fits your skills and abilities. Victory Care is currently looking for:

Presenters for Empowered Life	Empowered Life is a life skills program developed for delivery to small groups from the community. The program aims to develop financial and nutritional literacy. Presenters facilitate delivery of the content in partnership with a team of helpers.
Empowered Life Team members	Team members assist the presenter to deliver the Empowered Life Content, as well as contributing to a warm and welcoming atmosphere for each session. They chat with participants as well as helping with the practical work of meal parcels & morning tea etc.
Hamper Delivery	Operating since March 2020 as a service that delivers <i>food</i> hampers to people identified by OOSH, Care & Church to be experiencing levels of financial and food related stress and their need for extra support. Volunteers deliver the hampers, and take the opportunity where possible, to chat and pray with the clients.
Hamper Assembly	In the post COVID environment, access to hampers has dwindled so we investigated other low-cost alternatives to create our own hampers that need to be packed to create our Hamper Bank.
Donations Facilitator	To keep the costs of our initiatives down we need to investigate and source donations from businesses and the community. These could be for toiletries for hygiene packs, long life products for food hampers, sponsors and donors for Empowered Life, the Art Exhibition and Community Christmas Party.
Food Stall – Coles 'Secondbite' pick up	Each week on Tuesday and Wednesday at approximately 10am we need people to pick up donations from Coles Edgeworth's 'Secondbite' program. Volunteers meet at the Victory Centre at 10am and travel together in the church car to do the pickup. ( <i>The pickup requires a driver's licence to use the church car and the lifting of crates and boxes</i> ).
Food Stall – Facilitation	Each Tuesday and Wednesday after pickup, the goods from the Coles 'Secondbite' partnership needs to be sorted and displayed at the Victory Centre.
Food Stall Plus	We are looking for volunteers to meet with the community who attend our Food Stall each Tues & Wednesday from 12-2pm
Yard Maintenance - Team members	Help survivors of domestic violence and homelessness retain their rental properties. Team members work together with a Team Leader on the gardens and lawns of clients referred to us by domestic violence services such as NOVA and Jenny's Place. A commitment of 1 weekend per month is encouraged.
Yard Maintenance - Morning tea	Morning tea is an important point of connection with the client and the team in a Yard Maintenance visit. Costs can be covered by Victory Care. Delivery of morning tea to the can be separate from participation in the yard work aspect of the team.
Yard Maintenance - Team Leaders	Project managing the Yard Maintenance Team visits. Co-ordinating the team and the equipment on the day and reporting on the work done.
Art Exhibition helper	The Art Exhibition is a wonderful connection with the community and helps provide much needed funding for the Care we give. The Exhibition needs lots of helpers prior to the exhibition in setting up the space, hosting the exhibition and then packing down.
Community Christmas Party	This is a highlight of the year as clients across all our initiatives and services come together to celebrate Christmas in a generous and joyous event that has food, fun and a Gospel message. There are many different roles at this event set for Sat 2 <sup>nd</sup> Dec 9am – 2pm
Grant Writing	Victory Care is a Not For Profit charity operating as a Public Benevolent Institution so there are lots of grant application opportunities. If you have experience in this area and would like to assist us, we would love to hear from you.
Community Engagement & Donations Team	Developing corporate and business sponsorship as well as fundraising for the work of Victory Care is facilitated by a team of people. If you have a business network and would like to help resource the work of Victory Care this team is the place for you.
Money Mentors	Money Mentors are trained by CAP to teach financial literacy and help increase financial wellbeing. A Money Mentor walks alongside someone, supporting them to manage their financial situation.
